Dear Mr. Garegin Hambardzumyan,

The updated program “**Protection, Reproduction, and Rational Use of Hydrobiological Resources**” under the project Erasmus+ CBHE “**AFISHE / Development of Aquaculture and Fisheries Education for Green Deal in Armenia and Ukraine: from Education to Ecology**” at the Master’s degree (level 7) does not require a separate license and will be implemented into the educational process at the National University of Water and Environmental Engineering starting from September 2024.

According to Article 24 of the Law of Ukraine on Higher Education (<https://zakon.rada.gov.ua/laws/show/1556-18#Text>) since 2021, educational activities of a higher education institution at a specific level of higher education, i.e.: first (Bachelor's), second (Master's), third (PhD), are subject to licensing. Licensing is done by the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine and issued with no expiration date.

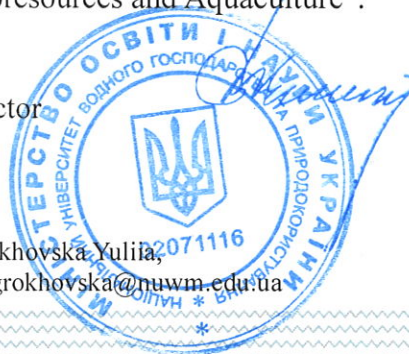
